Creation and Covenant

- Learn how to make the sign of the cross.
- The Bible is a precious book.
- School prayer.
- Morning, lunch and home time prayers.
- The Creation Story.

Communication and Language

- Engage in story times, asking questions and making comments.
- Speaking and listening games.
- Turn taking in conversations.
- Talk about themselves and their families.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Learn about school values.
- Talk about how to stay safe.
- Learn about what to do if they are feeling worried, sad, angry etc.
- Express feelings and regulate behaviour appropriately.

- Moving confidently in different ways.
- Revise and refine fundamental movement skills – rolling, crawling, jumping, running, skipping.

- Develop pencil grip.
